Applications in plain paper are invited from the interested individuals, seed firms/ companies for issue of non-exclusive licenses for multiplication, storage and sale of seeds of OUAT varieties protected under Protection of Plant Varieties and Farmers' Right Act 2001. The applicant should have required facilities for seed multiplication, processing, storage and sale of seeds in the concerned state. Separate application should be submitted for each variety for each state with required license fee. The license shall be issued for an initial period of 1 year from the date of issue of license which can be renewed to another year subject to satisfactory performance, payment of license fee and signing of agreement with OUAT. License fee shall be Rs.10.000/- (Rupees Ten Thousands only) per year per variety and shall be paid along with application in shape of bank draft drawn on a nationalized bank in favour of Dean of Research, OUAT, Bhubaneswar. Terms and conditions of issue of non-exclusive license is given below in separate sheet.

The application along with license fee should be sent to the Dean of Research, OUAT, Bhubaneswar-751003 in closed cover by registered post so as to reach to Dean Research on or before 25th May 2010. Applications reaching after stipulated date shall not be entertained. Those who have already applied in response to our earlier advertisement No.370/DR, dt.25.01.2010 need not apply again subject to fulfillment of other criteria but can opt the state for issue of non-exclusive license. The selected applicant will be called to produce the original documents in support of their claim and to execute the licensing agreement at Bhubaneswar. Successful applicant will be issued with non-exclusive license. The university reserves the right to issue license to any applicant or reject without assigning any reason there of.

Terms and conditions of licensing of OUAT varieties protected under PPV & FR Act, 2001

1. OUAT will issue license to interested parties for undertaking multiplication/sale and storage of seeds of the OUAT varieties registered under PPV & FR Act 2001
2. The license will be issued to interested applicants for multiplication, storage and sale of seeds of plant varieties.
3. The license shall be non-exclusive and issued for a period of 1 year which can be renewed for another year subject to satisfactory performance and payment of license fee and execution of licensing agreement.
4. The licensee will have the right to produce, store and sale the foundation and certified seeds after due certification of the protected varieties in respect of which he has been issued a license.
5. For production of foundation and certified seeds of varieties he has to obtain breeder seeds from the University on payment of cost of seeds. The licensee can only produce one stage of foundation seed for further multiplication and sale.
6. The licensee will have no right to issue sublicense or transfer the license to others without approval of University.
7. The licensee will be responsible for the maintenance of seed quality and genetic purity of seeds multiplied at his end.
8. The Licensee will indemnify the licensor (OUAT) from any legal consequences arising out of his deals in subsequent multiplication and transaction of seed or propagule.
9. Breeder of the crop variety or his successor shall be responsible for maintenance of nucleus seed and production of breeder seeds as per requirement of licensee. For the purpose the licensee should give indent to OUAT well in advance.
10. The licensee(s) shall be responsible to produce enough seed to meet the requirement of state government and other agencies and there should not be short supply of the seeds.
11. The licensee shall produce and sell seeds in the respective states as mentioned in the license agreement on a regular basis in sufficient quantity and at a reasonable price.
12. The licensee will use the registered denomination and OUAT logo on all packets of the licensed seed. The licensee may also use his own trade mark in the licensed seed
13. The University will have right to produce seeds to meet its own requirement.
14. The license fee should be fixed at Rs. 10,000/-(Rupees ten thousand) only per year per variety for a maximum coverage of ten hectare .Any additional hectare of seed area the licensee will have to pay Rs1000/-(One thousand) extra.
15. If the licensee violates the terms and conditions of license, the university may cancel the license after giving notice to the licensee.
16. In the event of any dispute between licensee and the licensor the same can be settled by the arbitrator appointed by the Vice-Chancellor and jurisdiction of Court shall be that of the Orissa High Court.
17. The licensee in his own interest should see the suitability of the licensed variety for the concerned state.
